Before coming to the meeting space in **Stafford I-1235**, you must first obtain a visitor's badge. Your name has been submitted to security, but you will need a valid ID to pick up your badge. If you are not a US Citizen, your passport will be required; if you are a US Citizen, a valid driver's license will be enough unless you are from the states of Maine, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, or Washington. **Please check <https://www.nsf.gov/about/visit/> for any special ID requirements that may apply to you.**

To pick up your badge, go to the NSF Information and Conference Center Desk located on the first floor of Stafford Place I at the North Stuart and 9th Streets entrance. Once you have obtained your visitor's badge, please proceed to the meeting space on the twelfth floor of Stafford Place I.

If you are traveling by Metro, take the Orange line to Vienna (Virginia) and get off at the Ballston-MU stop. Upon exiting Metro, proceed south on N. Stuart Street to the NSF entrance at the corner of N. Stuart and 9th Streets to pick up your badge.

If you are traveling by car, see Google maps (<http://maps.google.com/>) to obtain directions from your location using 4201 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia 22230 as the destination address.

Garage parking is available at 4121 Wilson Blvd. Arlington, VA 22230 in the 9th Street, and N. Stuart Street parking garages. Metered parking is available on the surrounding streets.
